The last few weeks of the year are traditionally a good time to review the past and make plans for the future. It is also a good time to consider helping organizations that make a difference in our lives.



New Geropsychiatry Outpatient Clinic

The Brookville Hospital Senior Transitions Unit recently expanded its services and opened an outpatient clinic to serve the needs of geriatric and psychiatric patients over the age of 55 in the surrounding areas.

Geriatric Psychiatrist, Dr. Raja Abbas, Medical Director of the Senior Transitions Unit will oversee the new program. Dr. Abbas, along with Nurse Practitioner, Sandra Stom, treat patients discharged from the inpatient unit, as well as outpatients in need of psychiatric and/or geriatric care with consistent follow-up.



Sandra Stom, CRNP, and Dr. Abbas offer compassionate care to patients and families who are coping with Alzheimer's, dementia, severe anxiety, depression and dangerous behaviors. For an appointment call 814-849-1870.
